~ MLA Style ~

This guide is based on the MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers 7th ed. (Modern Language Association 2009). We have provided examples of the most commonly-used formats. To view other citations online, go to the Library website (www.mxcc.commmnet.edu/library) > 'Help with your Research' > 'Following Guidelines' or visit the MxCC Library.

General rules: Title the list "Works Cited." *Include only sources that you have quoted, summarized, or paraphrased.* • List the items **alphabetically by author**, interfiling books, articles, etc. If no author is given, start with the first word of the title (other than A, An, or The). • **Double space** all lines and **indent** the second and following lines 5 spaces (or 1/2 inch). • *If you cannot find some of the required information, cite what is available.* • Abbreviate the names of all months except May, June, and July. • Most entries include either "print" or "web" to indicate format.

Author rules: **One** author: Last name, First name. • **2-3** authors: Last name, First name, and First name Last name. • **More than 3** authors: Provide the first author only, followed by et al. (ex: Quirk, Randolph, et al.).
